AirTran Airways Continues to Expand Service to Vacation Hotspots with Flights to Key West, Fla.

- Low Cost Airline to Provide Full-Sized Jets to the Conch Republic -

ORLANDO, Fla., Dec 17, 2009 /PRNewswire-FirstCall via COMTEX/ -- AirTran Airways, a subsidiary of AirTran Holdings, Inc. (NYSE: AAI), today launched nonstop service to Key West (Fla.) International Airport in from Orlando International Airport.

With four flights each week, AirTran Airways is the only low-cost carrier to provide scheduled, full-sized jet access to the island with its fleet of modern, Wi-Fi equipped Boeing 737s.
